

2023-2024 UPDATED COVID-19 VACCINE GUIDE

FALL VACCINE 2023

In September 2023, the CDC and FDA approved a new formulation of the COVID-19 vaccine for distribution. This formula was made to target the viruses that descended from the Omicron (XBB) variant.

GUIDANCE

Current CDC guidance states that:

- Everyone aged 5 years and older should get 1 dose of an updated COVID-19 vaccine for protection against serious illness from COVID-19.
- Children aged 6 months-4 years need multiple doses of COVID-19 vaccines to be up to date, including at least 1 dose of updated COVID-19 vaccine.
- People who are moderately or severely immunocompromised may get additional doses of updated COVID-19 vaccine.
