ACCESS TO COVID-19 VACCINES FOR THE UNINSURED AND UNDERINSURED

What is the Bridge Access Program?

This program provides FREE COVID-19 vaccines to adults (people 18 and up) who do not have insurance or whose insurance does not cover all of the COVID-19 vaccine costs.



What about children without insurance or children who are underinsured?

Pediatric populations under 19 years of age who do not have insurance or who are members of Federally-recognized Tribes will be covered by the Vaccines for Children (VFC) program.



How does a patient enroll in this program?

There is **no enrollment process** for eligible adults to get no-cost COVID-19 vaccines through this program.

Providers will ask patients whether they have health insurance to determine eligibility.



Where can I get a no-cost COVID-19 vaccine through this program?

You can find no-cost COVID-19 vaccines through this program at participating local health providers, health centers, and pharmacies.

How long will no-cost COVID-19 vaccines be available through this program?

The Bridge Access program will provide no-cost COVID-19 vaccines through December 31, 2024.
